

## GLYPHIS

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*Glyphis* Ach., *Syn. Meth. Lich.* 107 (1814); from the Greek *glypho* (to carve or engrave), in reference to the apparently incised lirellae.

Type: *G. cicatricosa* Ach.

Thallus crustose, corticolous; soredia and isidia absent. Ascomata rounded apothecia or elongate to irregular lirellae, immersed in a stroma. Proper exciple well-developed or lacking at the base. Hymenium I-, not inspersed. Ascospores 4–8 per ascus, elongate-ellipsoidal, 8–14-locular, with lenticular locules, or submuriform to muriform, hyaline to brown, I+ blue-violet.

Chemistry: No lichen compounds detected.

A tropical and subtropical genus of c. 30 corticolous species; three are known from Australia.
